

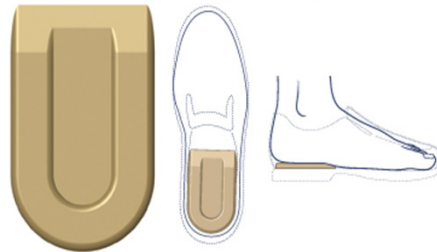

## Durable Medical Equipment Protocol

### □ **Step 1: Shoe & Insole Hygienic Refresher Spray**

Spray shoes, orthotics or insoles daily to reduce the risk of infection and re-infection.

### □ **Step 2: 1/4" or 1/8" Heel Lift**

Apply Heel Lift to shoe opposite the immobilized limb during ambulation to reduce the incidence of low back pain during treatment. The Heel Lifts can be stacked to obtain desired height.
